Summer Worship Weather Guidelines

The outdoor service will move to Zoom only if:

- Outdoor temperature is under 55 degrees
- Heat Advisory issued by the National Weather Service
- Precipitation or the threat of precipitation
- Wind interference with the sound system or camera system
- Other weather-related conditions or impending weather changes that would interfere with conducting a full worshipful service.
- If worship needs to be changed to do weather conditions it will be **Zoom Only**.
