Finally, I want you to know that **you are always welcome** to our worship services and other events. We have services in our sanctuary every Sunday at 10 AM (September through May), and we have summer services outside at 9 AM (June through August).

During our sanctuary services, we have childcare as well as a "prayground" in the sanctuary. During the summer services, we have both a "prayground" and a playground, and I hope to have fun activities after the services in order to enjoy the summer sunshine and weather.
