For Contemplation

It was the definitive feature of early Christian worship; it birthed the Church and even the New Testament. Its signs and symbols teach us how God acts and how we are to live. But most importantly in communion, we mysteriously become reassured of our union with Christ and his promises for us, which empowers us to live glorious and excellent lives.




