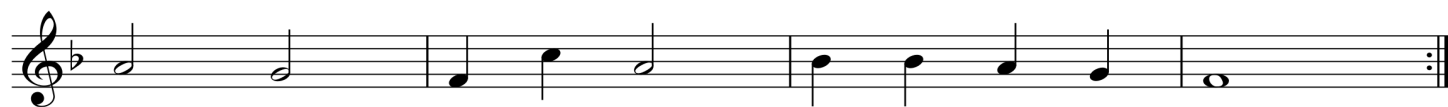

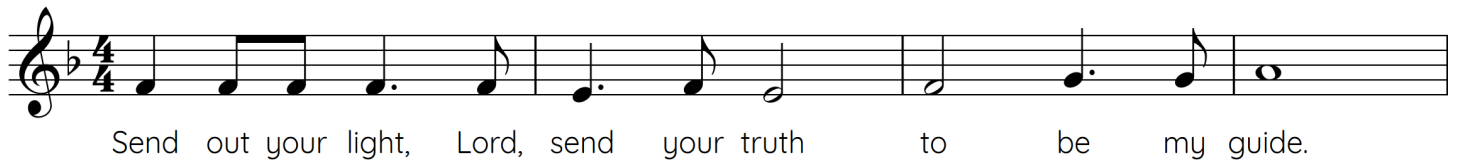
AFFIRMATION OF FAITH *Our World Belongs to God* §41
